## Year in Review

<ul> <li>2375 completer surveys sent</li> <li>832 returned (35% consortium response rate)</li> <li>EPP response rates ranged from 14 – 74%</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>1902 employer surveys sent</li> <li>488 returned (25.66% consortium response rate)</li> <li>EPP response rates ranged from 17-38%</li> </ul>

Greater variation in completer responses than employer responses

- Completer evaluates satisfaction with preparation by <u>program</u>
- Employer evaluates readiness of <u>completer</u>

#### Highest rating for both groups:

 Maintains a commitment to professional ethics, communicates effectively, and takes responsibility for and participates in professional growth that results in enhanced student learning

#### Lowest rating for both groups:

- Systematically gathers, analyzes, and uses all relevant data to measure student academic progress, guide
  instructional content and delivery methods, and provide timely feedback to both students and parents
  throughout the school year.
- Integrates diverse language and cultures into instruction to promote the value of multilingual / multicultural perspectives




